



Dear Charter Guest,

We hope that you are getting excited about your upcoming charter. Each sailing experience provides you with unique stories and memories that will not soon be forgotten. Once you are on the yacht, you are free to relax and take in the sights, sounds, and experience of sailing the British Virgin Islands. To make sure that you are well-prepared for your charter, we have listed some helpful information below to help you pack and make the arrival process as simplified as possible.

Current COVID-19 Travel Requirements and Protocols

The following protocols are required for **fully vaccinated travelers**:

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

- **A new ferry schedule has been issued for the month of October. To view the latest schedule, click [here](#).** Schedules are subject to change. For more frequent updates, please visit the BVI Ports Authority [here](#). **You must prebook your ferry tickets in advance.** There is a daily passenger limit of 65. Ferry tickets can be purchased direct with one of the following ferry service operators:

- **You must pre-register for a rapid antigen test via the Hummingbird Portal.**

- The following documentation is needed for entry into the British Virgin Islands:
 - Proof of a negative PCR test or approved antigen rapid test taken within 5 days prior to arrival.
 - Proof of full vaccination (Vaccination must be 2 weeks after the final dose of Moderna or Pfizer or 2 weeks after the single dose of Johnson&Johnson)
 - Proof of travel insurance that covers:
 - - COVID-19 medical costs, including hospitalisation, doctor's visits and prescriptions
 - Medical repatriation
 - Quarantine accommodation costs
 - Bring a hard copy of the following items with you:
 - Proof of vaccination

- Proof of negative test results

***Effective as of October 1, 2021, fully vaccinated travelers are exempt from the BVI Gateway Application process.**

UPON ARRIVAL

- Fully vaccinated travelers will **receive a rapid test upon entry for an additional fee of \$50 per person.** Test results are provided before leaving the airport or ferry port.
- Pay the \$10 per person BVI Environmental Fee (cash only).

WHILE IN THE BVI'S

- Be prepared to wear masks when ashore.
- Onboard snorkeling equipment will be assigned per person during your charter to prevent contamination.
- **As of August 7, 2021, a curfew is in place between 11:00pm - 5:00am nightly.** Restaurants and bars are open with the maximum capacity at 50 people per location.
- Take a PCR test within 48 hours of arriving in St. Thomas.

DEPARTURE

- Be prepared to show your negative test results, from your test taken during your trip, to the airlines prior to boarding.
- Tortola charges a \$20 per person departure tax.

For non-vaccinated travelers, please call for the more up to date entry protocols.

What should I pack?

When packing, keep in mind that storage space is limited. Since your luggage will need to be stored in your cabin along with your personal items, soft-sided luggage is required. We suggest that you bring a pair of sandals or flip flops for the time you spend ashore, but no shoes are to be worn on the yacht. **Bring plenty of sunscreen!!** Sunscreen sprays can make the boat deck slippery; therefore, we ask that you only bring lotion. It's a great idea to pack a dry bag to take your personal belongings onshore and a wide-brimmed hats or a sailing cap. During the cooler months, you may want a long sleeve t-shirt or cover up for the evenings. There are standard electrical outlets on board for your chargers, laptops, e-readers, and music players. Also, bring your favorite play list as you can connect your music players via blue tooth. We strongly suggest if you bring a hair dryer, bring a low wattage dryer (ie. travel size). Curling and flat irons are not allowed onboard. If you are planning on diving, you will also want to make sure that you bring your certification card. Don't forget those passports!

Now that you're all packed, you'll want to make sure you know exactly where you are going.

If you chose to take the connecting flight from San Juan or Barbados and arrive in Beef Island (EIS) Tortola, you are a short cab ride away from our base location at **Hodge's Creek Marina**. If you chose to arrive via St. Thomas (STT), you will need to take a taxi ride to the ferry dock where you will then take a water ferry to

Tortola. The downtown Charlotte Amalie ferry runs regularly throughout the day and is about a 50-minute ride to your destination at the Road Town, Tortola docks. Upon arrival, please be prepared to pay \$10 per person environmental fee (cash only) to the BVI Customs. Additionally, when departing the British Virgin Islands, there is a departure tax of \$20 per person by air, and \$20 per person by sea (we recommend having cash on hand in the event card is not available).

Taxi Services: Guests arriving and needing taxi service now are required to have a voucher with the name of the taxi service waiting for you. We recommend Sebastian's Transport for your taxi needs. You can book and pay for your services online at <https://transportbvi.com> and they can be reached at 284-496-7952. When looking for your taxi, the drivers usually can be identified by wearing bright orange shirts. Ask for Sebastian Transport, even if you have forgotten your service voucher. It is approximately a 10-minute taxi to **Hodge's Creek Marina**. It is important to note that you will not be able to board the yacht until 5pm on the day of arrival and that you will disembark at 9am on the day of departure.

What if I arrive at the dock before 5 pm?

Our office is located directly across from the docks on the second floor where you can check in, store your luggage, have access to WIFI or enjoy the lounge area. If you wish to venture around Tortola, a staff member can arrange taxi service. Shower/restroom facilities and changing rooms are also available on the first floor for our guests. Please note, the shower/restroom facilities are guarded by a code which a staff member will have to provide for you.

Diving on your Charter

Diving is available at an additional cost and will be conducted through an outside dive company and require proof of certification to participate. Be certain that you have indicated your interest in diving on the preference form and please let your crew know upon arrival.

Available Wi-Fi

Throughout your charter week, you will have the ability to purchase and access Wi-Fi on the yachts.

If you encounter any delays when arriving to the catamaran, please contact our base at **284-344-3722** or 284-541-0287 and they can notify your crew. Also, please use this as an emergency contact while on your vacation.
